i	The qualifying marks in each subject shall be 33%					
ii	For practical subject: The students need to score 33% out of 70 (Theory) and 33% out of 30 marks in Practical separately. For Non-Practical subjects: The students need to score 33% out of 80 (Theory) and 33% out of 20 Marks in Internal Assessment separately. However ,overall 33% marks is required to promote the students in the next higher class.					
iii	Students failing in one of the five subjects will be placed under compartment in that subject and students failing in more than 01 subject will be treated as ' Essential Repeat '					
iv	Supplementary Examination in the pattern of Annual Examination will be conducted 3 weeks after declaration of results (May be in the Third week of April 2023) by the Regional Office concerned.					
v	Students need to secure 33% in the supplementary examination(Theory only) to get qualify for the next higher class.
